





The tools of learning are different to each of us in turn.

These tools have helped us to learn and to better our talents. When we look back at them, they remind us of the past. The tools of learning are more than just tools to us; they are memories.





We also wish Mrs. Hehr well as she leaves the hallowed halls after several enjoyable years with us in Spanish & German.








